(INDIA-PAKISTAN)

WASHINGTON -- THE WHITE HOUSE TODAY MAILED THE UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY VOTE CALLING ON INDIA AND PAKISTAN TO OBSERVE A CEASEFIRE AS "SOLID EVIDENCE THAT THE MAJORITY OF WORLD OPINION SUPPORT THE POSITION" THE UNITED HAS TAKEN AGAINST THE USE OF MILITARY FORCE IN THIS CONFLICT.

PRESS SECRETARY RONALD L. ZIEGLER SAID THAT PRESIDENT NIXON TELEPHONED U.S. CHIEF DELEGATE TO THE U.N. GEORGE BUSH THIS MORNING TO EXPRESS HIS PLEASURE AT THE ACTION OF THE WORLD ORGANIZATION INVOTING 104-11 WITH 10 ABSTENTIONS FOR A CEASEFIRE AND TROOP WITHDRAWAL REQUEST.

"WE DON'T FEEL THIS VOTE WAS A CONDEMNATION OF ANY COUNTRY OR A CONDEMNATION OF ANY PEOPLE -- BUT WAS AN EXPRESSION THAT PROBLEMS LIKE THOSE OF SOUTH ASIA SHOULD NOT BE SOLVED BY A RESORT TO THE USE OF FORCE," ZIEGLER SAID.

"WE FEEL THE VOTE POINTS TO THE FACT THAT FORCE AND MILITARY CONFRONTATION IS NOT THE WAY TO SOLVE DISPUTES IN SOUTH ASIA AT THIS TIME," HE SAID.

ZIEGLER TOLD REPORTERS THAT THE PRESIDENT HAD CONFERRED WITH NATIONAL SECURITY AFFAIRS ADVISOR HENRY KISSINGER EARLIER TODAY AND HAD PUT IN A TELEPHONE CALL TO BUSH TO DISCUSS THE INDIA-PAKISTANI WAR.

HE SAID THERE HAS BEEN NO NEW DIRECT CONTACT WITH THE INDIAN GOVERNMENT ON THE WAR.

ZIEGLER ALSO, WITHOUT COMMENTING DIRECTLY, DISPUTED AN UNIDENTIFIED INDIAN SPOKESMAN'S CHARGE THAT THE WHITE HOUSE WAS USING "WORD OF MOUTH" IN OUTLINING THE DIPLOMATIC STEPS THE ADMINISTRATION HAD TAKEN TO TRY TO SOLVE THE DISPUTE PEACEFULLY.

"I WOULD SIMPLY REFLECT ON WHAT A WHITE HOUSE OFFICIAL SAID YESTERDAY," ZIEGLER SAID. "WE HAVE HAD EXTENSIVE CONTACTS WITH THE INDIAN GOVERNMENT. WE REPORTED A CATALOG OF THOSE CONTACTS YESTERDAY."

A TOP-LEVEL OFFICIAL TOLD REPORTERS THAT INDIA RESORTED TO WAR WHILE U.S. EFFORTS TO BRING CONCESSIONS FROM PAKISTAN, INCLUDING A RECOGNITION OF THE AUTONOMY OF BANGLA DESH, WERE SUCCEEDING. HE CHARGED THAT INDIA WAS MORE INTERESTED IN THE DISMEMBERMENT OF PAKISTAN THAN IN REACHING A PEACEFUL SOLUTION.
