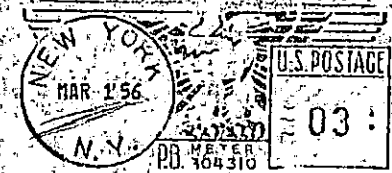

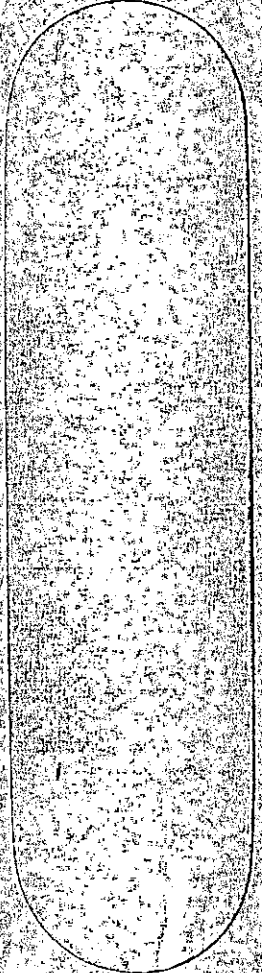

SERIES E & H UNITED STATES SAVINGS BONDS

CO-OWNERSHIP PROVISIONS

Purchases by one individual in any one calendar year of Series E Savings Bonds are limited to \$20,000 maturity value (\$15,000 purchase price), and of Series H Savings Bonds to \$20,000 (purchased at par).

However, additional holdings by individuals are permitted in cases where either Series E or H Bonds are registered in co-ownership form. Bonds issued to co-owners may, for the purpose of computing the amount held, be applied to the holdings of either or apportioned between them.

ILLUSTRATION OF CO-OWNERSHIP FEATURE

This is how the co-ownership feature allows for additional holdings by individuals in the case, for example, of a family of four, none of whom are registered owners or co-owners of Series E Bonds purchased in this calendar year: the husband can purchase \$20,000 (maturity value) in Series E Bonds in his own name, and if he wishes, he can also purchase an additional \$60,000 (maturity value) in Series E Bonds registered as follows: \$20,000 in his name with his wife as co-owner; \$20,000 in his name with one child as co-owner, and \$20,000 in his name with the other child as co-owner. The family unit is cited merely as an example, but any person may be named as co-owner. In the case illustrated, the husband as the sole owner of \$20,000 (maturity value) and as a co-owner of \$60,000 (maturity value) in Series E Bonds, would be entitled under the regulations to redeem all or part of the Bonds without obtaining the signature of any of the other co-owners.

The same co-ownership provisions apply to Series H Bonds inasmuch as purchase limits of E and H Bonds are applied separately. In the example above, the husband not only can purchase \$80,000 in Series E Bonds, but can also buy \$80,000 in Series H Bonds as well. Semi-annual interest checks on the full \$80,000 in H Bonds would be mailed to the owner and he would be entitled to redeem all or part of the Bonds without obtaining the signature of any of the other co-owners.

Series E - an appreciation Savings Bond which earns interest for as long as 19 years 8 months (10 years after original maturity).

Series H - a current income Savings Bond paying interest twice a year by Treasury check and maturing in 9 years 8 months. The H Bond is issued and redeemed at par.
