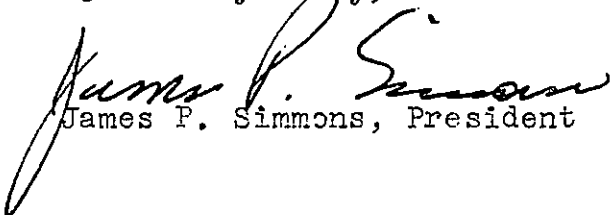
Dear George:

On September 18 the Air Space Sub-Committee of the Civil Aeronautics Administration will hold its third meeting considering allocation of air space to military aircraft in a vast area in West Texas and Eastern New Mexico. The enclosed map indicates the areas and altitudes being requested by the military as their exclusive areas of operation.

We fully realize the necessity of proper space allocation to military aircraft and the necessity of intense training for the men flying these craft. However, it is the opinion of the Aviation Committee of the Midland Chamber of Commerce that, if the requested space is allocated, civil aviation will be greatly hindered, with little or no appreciable benefit to the military. In the opinion of many who are in a position to know, the military jet aircraft operate largely above the prescribed maximum altitude of civil aircraft in the specified areas. It is our contention that this maximum altitude for civil aircraft should be raised to 16,000 feet, particularly in the area northeast of Midland. This would give the military aircraft air space above the operating level of most civil aircraft, and, at the same time, give them unhindered training space at their normal operating altitude.

We respectfully request that you impart your views on this matter to Mr. L. C. Elliott, Regional Chairman, Air Space Sub-Committee, Civil Aeronautics Administration, P. O. Box 1689, Fort Worth, Texas. Please be assured that our's is not an effort to hinder in any way the necessary operations of our military aircraft, but rather is an effort to reach a happy medium wherein both civil and military aviation may continue to operate.

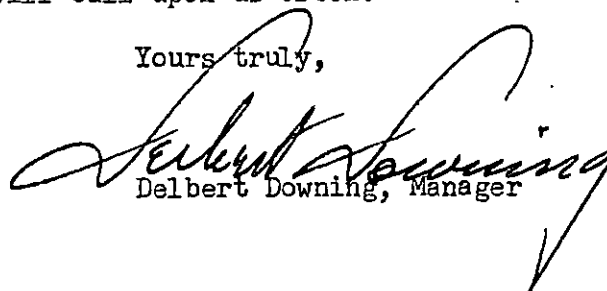
