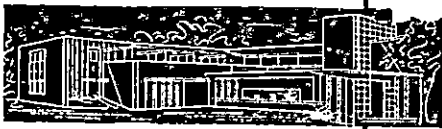

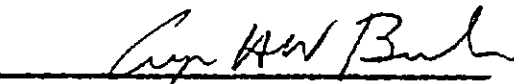

SEMINAR ON AGING, WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY, ST. LOUIS, MO.

1. There are 127,000,000 people in the U.S. who are insured through various health insurance programs; 75,000,000 are insured through private companies; the balance are insured through non-profit organizations, such as Blue Cross.
2. A new vogue in health insurance that is in experimental stage is a paid up medical care program similar to paid up life insurance at a particular age. This program is most costly during the working years but affords a partial solution to rendering hospital care for the aged population.
3. It has been estimated that people over age 65 require more than two times the medical care of the younger aged groups. It is estimated that there will be 32,000,000 over age 65 by the year 2000 and that this will constitute 10% of our nation's population.
4. Principal diseases of the aged are mental disease and cardiovascular disease.
5. Legislation has been passed in the current session of Congress to assist states in defraying hospital costs for the aged. This legislation is called the Kerr-Mills Bill. States must provide matching funds in order to participate. Thus far, 14 states and 2 possessions have enacted enabling legislation (Texas is supporting this approach and has approved the bill. However, enabling legislation providing matching funds have not been appropriated.).
6. An administrator in Illinois has experimented with a nursing home as part of the general hospital. The following points seem to be of particular interest:
 - a. Close proximity of the nursing home to the hospital provides a much better opportunity for the attending physician to routinely visit the nursing home or geriatric patient.
 - b. The nursing home is considered an integral part of the hospital and enjoys such status.
 - c. The nursing home program is primarily staffed by non-professional personnel, thus keeping down the cost of operation.
 - d. Medical care is administered by the medical staff of the general hospital.
 - e. This particular unit has facilities for 33 patients.
 - f. In 4 years of operation, its average occupancy has been 95%.
 - g. All admissions to this unit are voluntary (no committed patients);

- h. The hospital administrator is the final word in approving admissions.
- i. Admissions occur in the early afternoon in order to provide the patient with a daytime orientation to the unit.
- j. Weekly interim social case histories are accomplished on all patients with information referred to the physician in an effort to plan for discharge.
- k. Nutritional instructions are available to patients and the patient's family.
- l. An occupational therapy program is conducted by the hospital auxiliary.
- m. The hospital chaplain serves this unit as a part of the hospital.
- n. There are no visitor restrictions.
- o. The average length of stay of the patient in this unit is 159.2 days.
- p. The cost of maintaining a patient in this quasi selfcare program is approximately 50% of maintaining a patient in a general hospital bed.
- q. Rates are based on a care level and average \$ 7.00 to \$ 8.00 per day plus drugs, x-rays, and the usual additional charges.
- r. The employee to patient ratio in this service is 1 to 1, contrasted with the average per employee to patient in a general hospital of 2 1/2 to 1.

In summary, it should be remembered that as a general rule autonomous or or specialized programs are more expensive to operate than a program which would be a subordinate program of a parent institution. The reason for this rests in supervisory duplication, i.e. one director of nursing service, one dietitian, one medical record librarian, one administrator, and one pharmacist to supervise the parent unit and its tentacle,
