Whenever practicable such notices shall be given on blanks prescribed by the Veterans Administration. Upon receipt by the Veterans Administration, a valid designation or change of beneficiary shall be deemed to be effective as of the date of execution: *Provided*, That any payment made before proper notice of designation or change of beneficiary has been received in the Veterans Administration shall be deemed to have been properly made and to satisfy fully the obligations of the United States under such insurance policy to the extent of such payments.

MANNER OF PAYMENT OF DEATH BENEFITS

1. **PAYMENT TO FIRST BENEFICIARY.**—(a) If the beneficiary to whom payment is first made is under 30 years of age at the date of death of the insured, benefits are payable in 240 equal monthly installments of \$5.51 for each \$1,000 of insurance.

2. **PAYMENT AFTER DEATH OF FIRST BENEFICIARY.**—Upon due proof of death of the first beneficiary after payment has been made of at least one installment, thereafter monthly installments in the same amount shall be paid to the person or persons entitled as beneficiary until all of the installments certain shall have been paid.

3. **CLASS AND ORDER OF PAYMENT TO OTHER THAN DESIGNATED BENEFICIARY.**—If no beneficiary is designated by the insured, or if the designated beneficiary or beneficiaries (including contingent beneficiaries) should not survive so as to receive any installment or installments of insurance, or should die prior to completion of payment of the monthly installments certain payable under the provisions of the National Service Life Insurance Act of 1940, as amended, and the terms of the policy, the installments of insurance remaining unpaid at the death of the insured or of any beneficiary, as the case may be, shall be paid to the person or persons then in being within the permitted classes of beneficiaries hereinafter specified and in the order named:

- (4) If no widow, widower, child, or parent, to the brothers and sisters of the insured (including those of the half blood) if living, in equal shares.

4. **LIMITATIONS ON ENTITLEMENT AND PAYMENT.**—No person shall have a vested right to any installment or installments of the insurance. No installment of insurance shall be paid to the heirs, creditors, or legal representatives as such of the insured or of any beneficiary. Any payment of insurance made to a person represented by the insured to be within the permitted class of beneficiaries shall be deemed to have been properly made and to satisfy fully the obligations of the United States under such insurance policy to the extent of such payments.
