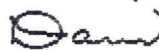

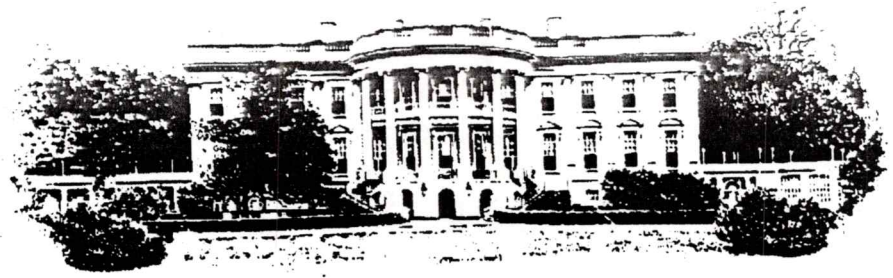

You are scheduled to meet with leaders of five corporations with major stakes in the B-2 program. We recommended you have this meeting if for no other reason than that the leaders of these companies will not be able to say that they were ignored if there is a decision to scale-back the B-2 program. They know you will be in a listening mode only, but want very much to make their case directly to you. Their sources tell them the decision has been made by Secretary to procure only 20-25 aircraft. They will tell you that this is the same as no program because this smaller number will not be supported by the Congress.

I expect them to make the following points:

- They have developed a major national asset that works as advertised and we should go ahead with it now. The companies have made major investments in people, technology, and facilities.
- The B-2 production decision has an important job dimension in a depressed economy and a faltering aerospace industry. There are 40,000 to 50,000 direct jobs at stake plus numerous indirect jobs.
- The retention of the defense industrial base is at stake.
- The B-2 is a flexible platform of unparalleled capability in a very uncertain world -- with capabilities in both conventional and nuclear arenas.

I think you saw a note from Wilma earlier regarding a request from Tom Korologos to see the General on the 10th -- the day of your return to the office.

Korologos wants to bring in the CEOs of General Electric, LTV, Boeing, Hughes, and Northrop to discuss the B-2 program for 20 minutes. Not sure that such a meeting will make any difference, but these guys are high rollers. They will tell the General the importance of the airplane and the dire consequences to their people if the program is scaled back.

Even though such a meeting is unlikely to make any difference in any decision taken by the Administration, I would think the General ought to see them so they cannot say they didn't have their day in court or that they were ignored.

Unfortunately, the only day they will all be in town is the 10th. Would you ask the General if he will see Tom and his associates on that day and let me know? (We have blocked 2:00pm, but haven't told Tom anything.)
