Dear Mrs. Bush;

I am writing this letter to you because I feel that you are an open minded person. This particular quality is a prerequisite when dealing with the subject of this letter, which is-UFOs. Congratulations! If you are still reading this letter-then my intuition about you has proved to be correct.

And now, I will get to the point of this letter, which is that people are being hurt Mrs. Bush. Unfortunately, I mean this quite literally. My brother and I have been doing research on the UFO phenomenon for the last 12 months for the purpose of producing a non-profit "citizen's documentary" on this subject. In our correspondence with other UFO researchers, witnesses, and especially alleged UFO abduction victims, we have found a disturbing cycle of harassment(both physical and mental)being directed towards these people and their families.

One person in particular has reported to us of being physically abused, having their phone tapped on many occasions, having their mail tampered with and death threats over their phone. Both I and this person believe members of the C.I.A.(and/or)some other covert Govt./Military agencies to be the perpetrators of this harassment.

Any attempts to report this harassment to the authorities has been treated in a "don't call us-we'll call you" sort of manner. I quite honestly feel that this person is in danger. In our research, we have attempted to use the Freedom of Information Act to try and get documents, which we feel could prove that the U.S. Govt. has been/and is currently involved with UFOs and their occupants. Most replies to our FOIAs have been fruitless-that is-all except for one.

We feel that the FOIA letter, which we have enclosed(a copy of the original), is very important indeed. We would greatly appreciate it if you would show this letter to your husband to see what he thinks about it. Because of this document, we have been told by other researchers, who have seen it, that we had better start "looking over our shoulders" from now on.

I know that this all must sound so "cloak and dagger" to you, and I must admit that I had my doubts in the beginning as to the validity of this subject. But after speaking to and hearing from so many people, who are involved in this subject(willingly or unwillingly)with nothing to gain and everything to lose, I feel that it is time for the U.S. Govt. to confront these issues both openly and honestly.

I have already written to Mr. Bush twice. I received no replies to my letters. Any assistance that you could provide, in so far as investigating this matter, would be greatly appreciated!

Dear Mr. Buzzetta:

This is in response to your letter dated 15 May 1990 in which you appealed the decision of this agency, dated 1 May 1990, neither to confirm nor deny the existence or nonexistence of records pertaining to your 21 March 1990 Freedom of Information Act request. Specifically, you requested information on "an altercation which occurred in 1978-79' at either the CIA's Dulce, New Mexico Lab (or) at the Groom Lake (Area 51/S4 Facility) in Nevada. As a result of this altercation 44 Scientists were killed and approximately 20 Delta Force personnel died."

Your appeal has been presented to the appropriate member of the Central Intelligence Agency Information Review Committee, Mr. Thomas A. Twetten, Deputy Director for Operations. Pursuant to the authority delegated under paragraph 1900.51(a) of Chapter XIX, Title 32 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Mr. Twetten has determined that the fact of the existence or nonexistence of any documents which would be responsive to your request is classified pursuant to Executive Order 12356. Further, the fact of the existence or nonexistence of such documents would relate directly to information concerning intelligence sources and methods which the Director of Central Intelligence has the responsibility to protect from unauthorized disclosure in accordance with Subsection 102(d)(3) of the National Security Act of 1947 and Section 6 of the Central Intelligence Agency Act of 1949. Accordingly, pursuant to Freedom of Information Act exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3), your appeal is denied. By this statement, we are neither confirming nor denying that any such documents exist.

In accordance with the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, you have the right to seek judicial review of the above determination in a United States district court.

We appreciate your patience while your appeal was being considered.
