## **Parent Chaperones**

Wristbands (which will be provided by The Pavilion) are for teachers, chaperones and bus drivers - NOT students. All parent chaperones must have a wristband to enter the venue. If a parent arrives without a wristband, the lead teacher will be notified via text and is required to assist the parent at the venue gates. The Pavilion does not allow parents to enter the venue without a wristband and/or explicit approval from the lead teacher.



### Field Trip Performance Details

Completing the online registration form automatically reserves seats for your group to see the two Main Stage performances. The live performances run approximately 45 minutes each with a small lunch/bathroom break in-between sets. Please consider the length of time your students will be seated when registering for the field trip.



### **Educational Zone Lottery Process**

Select classes will be picked to attend a hands-on educational zone in lieu of a stage performance. Selections are made via a <u>random lottery system</u> and entries into the lottery are strictly based on class size and grade level. Each zone has a maximum number of students it can accommodate. **If you are not selected for a zone, your guests will be assigned reserved seats to watch the fun and interactive stage performances.** 



### **Bus Parking Restrictions**

Once buses have parked, they will not be able to leave until the school has officially been dismissed from the venue (unless there is an emergency). If you need to leave to return to school before the event dismissal time of 1pm, please contact Ashley Gravois to make arrangements at least one week before the field trip.



### **Lunches for Field Trip Attendees**

Students must bring their lunch and will have the opportunity to eat in their seats during the performances and designated break. Lunch is NOT provided by The Pavilion. Concession stands will be closed. No food or beverages will be sold during School Days. There are no on-site vending machines. Please advise all teachers, chaperones and bus drivers to bring their own lunches or snacks.



### Bag Policy for Teachers + Chaperones

The Pavilion strictly follows the NFL Clear Bag Policy. Clear bags should be 12" x 12" or smaller. Non-clear bags must be 4.5" x 6.5" or smaller. School-assigned drawstring bags for teachers and medical bags will be permitted. Rolling coolers for lunches are permitted. NO student backpacks will be allowed inside the venue. Please inform all teachers, parent chaperones and bus drivers of size restrictions.
