COMPLETE CHECKLIST

Phase 1: Asset Gathering (1-2 hours)

Written Content

- Collect 5-10 blog posts or articles
- Gather 50-100 social media posts
- Compile 20-30 emails you've written
- Include any books, guides, or PDFs you've created
- Add any other written content in your voice
- Goal: Minimum 50-100 pages total**

Video & Audio Content

- Gather YouTube videos (if available)
- Collect podcast episodes or guest appearances
- Include webinar or presentation recordings
- Add training videos or course content
- Compile any other video where you're speaking
- Goal: Minimum 30-60 minutes of clear audio**

Images

- Gather 3-5 professional headshots
- Collect 10-15 casual photos
- Include different expressions (smiling, serious, thoughtful)
- Add different angles (front, side, ¾ view)
- Include various outfits and settings Ensure all photos are solo shots (no one else in picture)
- Goal: Minimum 20-30 high-quality images**
- Verify HIGH QUALITY and GOOD LIGHTING for all images

Knowledge Base Documentation

- Document your frameworks and methodologies
- Compile course materials or training content
- Gather client work examples or case studies
- Write out your philosophies and beliefs
- List FAQs you answer repeatedly

Phase 2: Brain Clone Setup (2-4 hours)

Platform Selection

- Choose ONE platform to start:
 - Custom ChatGPT (for specific, repetitive tasks)
 - Claude Projects (for project-level work)
 - UgenicIQ (for comprehensive master brain)

Content Upload

- For ChatGPT:** Upload ONLY content related to specific task
- For Claude Projects:** Upload ONLY content related to that project
- For UgenicIQ:** Upload anything and everything (no limits)

Alternative: No Content Yet?

- Option A: Use Claude/ChatGPT with knowledge extraction prompt
- Option B: Use UgenicIQ's onboarding system
- Answer guided questions to build your brain

Testing Your Brain Clone

- Write a social media post in your style
- Explain one of your frameworks
- Create an outline for a presentation on your topic
- Answer a common question from your audience
- Evaluate: Does it sound like you?**
- If not, provide more examples and feedback

Claude or ChatGPT Brain-Creation Prompt

I need you to help me build a comprehensive "brain" document that captures my expertise, beliefs, frameworks, and stories for content creation.

Your job: Ask me one focused question at a time. After each answer, ask 1-2 follow-up questions to go deeper. Continue this process across multiple areas (business philosophy, communication style, key frameworks, origin stories, core beliefs, content preferences, audience understanding, etc.) until you have enough depth to create a detailed artifact.

Once we've covered sufficient ground, compile everything into a structured document that any LL can use to write content that truly sounds like me and represents my thinking.

Start with your first question.

Artifact Iterative Prompt:

Can you create a document artifact for me that you continue to update as I answer your questions so I have one document that is tracking everything.

Phase 3: Voice Clone Setup (30-60 minutes)

Platform Setup

- Create account at elevenlabs.io
- Navigate to voice cloning section

Voice Clone Type Selection

- Instant Clone:** Quick setup, basic quality, good for testing
- Professional Clone:** Requires audio recording, higher quality, production ready

Audio Recording Guidelines

- Use a good microphone (at minimum, use A mic)
- Record 30-60 minutes minimum of clear audio
- Create different clones by TYPE of video (professional, casual, etc.)
- Ensure clean file with no disruptions
- Verify only your voice is in the recording
- Don't mix different video styles
- Ensure good audio quality for lip-sync

Upload & Training

- Upload your audio sample to ElevenLabs
- Wait for AI training (typically completes quickly)
- Receive notification when ready

Testing Your Voice Clone

- Generate at least a paragraph of test audio
- Render the file multiple times** (results vary per rendering)
- Listen critically: Does it sound like you?
- Check emotional range
- Test different sentence structures

Audio Engineering for Emotion

- Learn to use **ALL CAPS** for emphasis and intensity
 - Use **!** for excitement and energy
 - Use **?** for curiosity and questioning
 - Use **...** for pauses and dramatic effect
 - Access **FREE CustomGPT** for audio engineering assistance

Phase 4: Image Clone Setup (30-45 minutes)

Photo Preparation

- Gather profile shots of **BOTH** sides
- Include top-down and bottom-up angles
- Include full body shots **AND** sitting shots
- Ensure solo shots only (no one else in pictures)
- Include mix of facial expressions (smiles, serious, thoughtful)
- Verify **HIGH QUALITY** images
- Verify **GOOD LIGHTING** in all photos

Platform & Upload

- Choose image generation platform
- Upload your training photos to the platform
- Allow AI to process and create model

Image Generation

- Use prompts to describe desired images
 - Generate multiple variations
 - Build a library of images
 - Save the ones you love
 - Note:** Be ready to generate multiple times - photos make a **BIG** difference

Phase 5: Video Clone Setup (1-2 hours)

Choose Your Path

- IMAGE to VIDEO:** Faster, easier, no filming required (lower quality)
- VIDEO to VIDEO:** Highest quality, most realistic (requires filming)

Platform Selection

- HeyGen** - Most popular, easiest (recommended for beginners)
- Higgsfield** - Cutting-edge technology
- Veo3** - Newest technology

For VIDEO to VIDEO Path - Recording Guidelines

- Use high-quality camera (phone works if high quality)
- LIGHTING IS KING** - ensure excellent lighting
- Record minimum 2 minutes, recommend 3+ minutes
- NO MISTAKES ALLOWED** in recording
- Limit hand gestures
- Limit facial expressions (not too much)
- Ensure good audio for lip-sync
- Use closer up shots (though this is rapidly changing)

Upload & Training

- Create account on chosen platform
- Upload your video sample
- Wait for AI to analyze face and movements (30-60 minutes)
- Receive notification when ready

Testing Your Video Clone

- IMAGE to VIDEO:** Test different prompts and environments
 - VIDEO to VIDEO:** Check if training material was sufficient
 - Re-run generation (each run produces different results)
 - Watch critically: Does it look natural?
 - Check lip-sync accuracy**

Phase 6: Super Agent Integration

Workflow Creation

1. **Brain clone** writes the script
2. **Voice clone** records audio
3. **Image clone** creates thumbnail
4. **Video clone** creates the video

Content Production

- Start with ONE piece of content
- Test your full workflow
- Refine and optimize
- Then scale up production
- Remember: Version 1, then iterate**

Community Engagement

- Post your progress in Facebook group
- Share your completed clone
- Compete for best clone prize

Equipment Checklist

Camera

- Recommended:** Your smartphone
- Budget option: ~\$200-300
- Mid-range option: ~\$500-700
- Professional option: ~\$1000+

Microphone (Critical for Quality)

- Budget: USB mic ~\$50-75 (e.g., Blue Snowball)
- Mid-range: XLR mic ~\$150-200 (e.g., Audio-Technica AT2020)
- Professional: High-end mic ~\$300-500
- Remember: Audio quality matters MORE than video quality**

Lighting

- Free option: Natural light (use what you have)
- Budget: Ring light ~\$30-50
- Better: LED panel lights ~\$100-150
- Best: 3-point lighting kit ~\$200-300

Other Equipment

- Tripod or phone mount (~\$20-50)
- Quiet recording space (free - use a closet if needed)
- Simple backdrop (fabric, wall, or green screen ~\$30-100)
- Computer or laptop (you probably have this)

- Custom ChatGPT account OR
- Claude account OR
- UgenticIQ account

Voice Clone

- ElevenLabs account

Image Clone

- Image generation platform account (multiple options available)

Video Clone

- HeyGen account OR
- Higgsfield account OR

Pro Tips to Remember

- Don't skip the asset gathering step (1-2 hours preparation)
 - The better your ingredients, the better your clone
 - Start with what you have - don't wait for perfect
 - Build one clone at a time
 - Upgrade equipment as you grow
 - Version 1 first, perfect later**
 - Most people already have 80% of needed equipment

Quality Checkpoints

Before Moving to Next Phase

- Does my brain clone sound like me?
- Is my voice clone emotionally accurate?
- Do my image clones look natural?
- Does my video clone pass the "natural movement" test?
- Have I tested the complete workflow at least once?

Final System Check

- All four clones created and tested
 - Workflow documented and repeatable
 - First piece of content produced
 - Ready to scale production
